The 2025 Citizen's Academy Sessions are scheduled to begin February 20, 2025 and will run for eight (8) consecutive weeks from 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. at the City of Newport Municipal Building, 998 Monmouth Street in the Multi-Purpose Room, with a final graduation ceremony on Thursday, April 10, 2025. The program is FREE and available to all City of Newport Citizens, Commissions, Boards or Business Owners. Class size is limited to Twenty (20) participants. Applications are available online at newportky.gov or at 998 Monmouth Street, 2nd Floor and are due no later than February 3, 2025. All applicants must be accepted in the class and will have a background check by the Newport Police Department prior to taking the class. WEEK 1: FEBRUARY 20th CITY OF NEWPORT LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Learn the core functions of city government and how elected officials and the city manager work both independently and collaboratively to make city and policy decisions. Presented by: Mayor Tommy Guidugli Jr., John Hayden, City Manager and Brian Steffen, Assistant City Manager. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor.

WEEK 2: FEBRUARY 27th FINANCE DEPARTMENT

The Finance Director will describe the budgeting process and give a budget overview and the financial transparency platform and how your tax dollars work for you and the community. He will also give an overview of the different functions in the department. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor.

WEEK 3: MARCH 6th POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Police Chief and Command Staff will educate everyone on how the Police Department functions on a daily basis and how they provide the upmost of safety to our community. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor.

WEEK 4: MARCH 13th FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Fire Chief and/or Command Staff will educate everyone on how the Fire Department works on a daily basis to provide the upmost of safety in our community. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor with a Tour of the Fire Department.

WEEK 5: MARCH 20th PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT AND THE CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENTS

The Planning & Development, Code Enforcement and Animal Control Officer will educate everyone on city regulations, code violations, health and safety and how their functions work and how they impact the community. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor.

WEEK 6: MARCH 27th COMMUNITY SERVICES, PARKS & RECREATION, BUSINESS LIAISON OFFICER AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION

Community Services, Parks & Recreation, the Business Liaison Officer and Historic Preservation will give overviews and educate everyone on their functions and daily operations and how they impact the community such as Street Cleaning, Trash Pickup, Snow Removal, Park Facilities, Veteran's Memorial Pool Facility etc. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor with a City wide bus tour.

WEEK 7: APRIL 3rd MUNICIPAL OPERATION & COMMUNITY LIAISON AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR

The Municipal Operation & Community Liaison and Economic Development Coordinator will give overviews and educate everyone on their functions. Classes will be at the Municipal Building in the Multi-Purpose Room, first floor.
